## BAFA MEMBERS ONLY EXHIBITION

- Commissions** 25% to SHPT and 5% to Bafa on art works (total 30%).
- Requirements** No portfolio (browser) unframed work will be accepted. Work must not exceed 120cm by 100cm (48 by 39 inches) inclusive of frame where applicable. Please ensure that all frames and canvases are ready to hang fitted with 'D' rings and taut wire or cord, fixed approximately one third from the top of the frame or canvas. Each entry must be clearly labelled on the back with Name of artist, Title of work, Medium, Price and Contact Number.
- Free standing** Pottery and sculpture must have any special facilities required to display the work provided by the artist. Please contact Clare Tebboth [bafa@tebboth.com](mailto:bafa@tebboth.com) to confirm that your arrangements are suitable.
- Suitability** This exhibition will be open to members of the public of all ages so work must be suitable for family viewing. The decision to accept work will rest with the hanging committee.
- Copyright** Copies of work by another artist must always acknowledge the original work in the title. Responsibility for infringing the copyright of any other person lies solely with the artist.
- Handing in** Artists will be asked to unwrap their exhibits in the unwrapping area before presenting them at the check in desk. Please retain your packaging as we will be unable to store it.
- Insurance** Bafa provides third party liability insurance for risks to the public. Exhibitors are advised to insure their work for all risks. Although all reasonable care is taken, no responsibility can be accepted by Bafa for loss or damage to exhibits.
- Cards** A maximum of 50 Cards can be entered, individually priced no multiple pricing allowed. Please check these in at the separate table. Prices to be in 50p's or £1's e.g. £1.50 or £2 not £1.75

**Any exhibit not complying with the rules will not be displayed. No refund will be made and the Bafa committee's decision is final.**
